At this time of awareness concerning the COVID-19 virus, we here at Carl Larson Cancer Center want to assure you that we are taking all available measures to ensure your safety. Not only for you, but for your loved ones as well.

Having made this commitment to patient and family safety, we would like to encourage the following measures that will assist us in providing safe care for all involved:

- If you or a family member are experiencing “flu-like” symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat), please do not come for your appointments as scheduled. Please call to re-schedule or for further assistance in deciding on your next action.
- Please be aware that even though we are a health care facility, we do not have access to tools for diagnosing and testing for the COVID-19 virus currently. If you experience any symptoms listed above, go to your family doctor or to a local hospital or care area for further testing.

As a cancer center, many of our patients are under current chemotherapy or radiation treatment and have other pre-existing conditions that make them vulnerable to this virus. To take steps to prevent the spread of this virus among our patients, family members, and staff, we will be conducting measures upon entry to the building to determine if it is safe for each person to enter.

Patients, family members, and staff will be asked questions regarding their current symptoms and will have their temperature taken prior to entering the building.

We will continue to follow guidance from the CDC and state officials to do our best in keeping our patients and community safe.
